

Curringa Farm


The Hamilton Sheep Centre is located on Curringa Farm, 3km west of Hamilton on the Lyell Highway. We are only one hour from Hobart, en route to Strahan and close to Mt Field National Park and Russell Falls. The Hamilton Sheep Centre is the perfect venue for a day trip in the Rivers Run touring route region.

Situated on a 300 hectare working sheep farm in the beautiful Derwent Valley, we cater for people who want an interesting day out in the country. Our standard groups program includes a sheep shearing and working sheep dog display complemented by a three course home cooked meal.

A 30 minute farm nature tour is also included in our morning or afternoon tea package. This presents a wonderful opportunity to get a little way (3 kms) off the beaten track and to see the full extent of land management and conservation based activities in practice on the farm. You may also see a sea eagle, wedgetail eagle, echidna or platypus in the wild.

The farm is very diverse with sheep, cattle, poppies, cabbages, peas and grass seed as agricultural enterprises. There is a very strong landcare focus on the property with tree planting, management of water quality and soil health all being fundamental activities. Fauna appreciation of native birds, animals and insects is all part of our operation, providing habitat and sustainable systems for biodiversity.

Our passion is to share our property with the public. Discussions on land management, crop production and the wool sheep enterprises are very interactive and informative for visitors. Mini tour packages are available for the FIT visitor.
